Class 1

In this first class you will review/learn how to **cast on**, **read a simple pattern**, **do a 'yarn over'** and **knit-2-together** as you make one of these fun and useful dishcloths or a 'tea-bag pouch' (great hostess gifts, by the way)

Class 2

We will look at your completed 1st project and figure out what's right and what's wrong. Then we'll cast off and start our next project of fabulous mittens and learn about **increasing, creating the thumb, and decreasing.**



Class 3

We'll continue with our mittens. This is a more complicated pattern and you'll soon feel confident to do anything!



Class 4

We'll finish up the mittens (if necessary), including sewing them up. We'll then start a matching hat and learn how to knit on a circular needle in-the-round. Lots of time for questions too!
